This document suggests evidence suitable to submit in support of an RPL application for the TAERES501 Apply research to training and assessment practice. This unit of competency provides the necessary skills and knowledge required to undertake research into educational theory and apply this research to improve current training and assessment practice. It applies to those who need to develop skills in research in order to apply educational theory to improve current and future training, and assessment practice.

When submitting your evidence, ensure it is from the <u>present or very recent past.</u> This generally means it needs to be from within the past 2-3 years. Please email the evidence to <u>rpl@plenty.edu.au</u> with the unit title inserted as the subject heading.

EV01 – TAERES501	completing at least one research project that includes:  • a research brief, including purpose of research, rationale, methodology, research activities, timeframe, resources required and expected outcomes  • wide research into educational theory  • analysis of data in relation to its application, to improving current and future training, and assessment practice  • recommendations for action to improve current and future training, and assessment practice  • criteria to monitor and evaluate new practices, based on research  finalising one research report using academic referencing and citation protocols  conducting a review of the research process with recommendations for future research.	A copy of at least one research project report showing all dot points listed in the "Evidence of:" column (column to the left of this column) and preferably including a literature review section.  Along with the report, you will be required to provide:  • documents such as memos / notices evidencing need / appeal for research or research brief  • minutes of meetings, email threads or other documented communications to discuss research proposal / needs /approval to proceed.  • data collection instruments (blank or completed and deidentified) such as surveys/questionnaires  All academic referencing and citation protocols should be able to be seen in the finalised research report.  Feedback/review of report. Could include notes, letters, feedback, recommendations, third party reports evidencing review/feedback process and/or drafts of research proposals with marked up comments or feedback attached.
